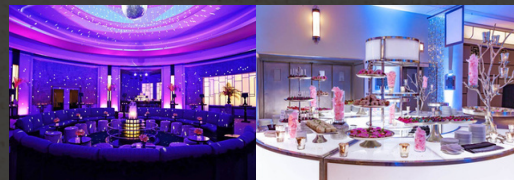

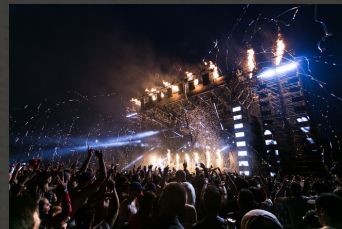

GENERAL FEEDBACK

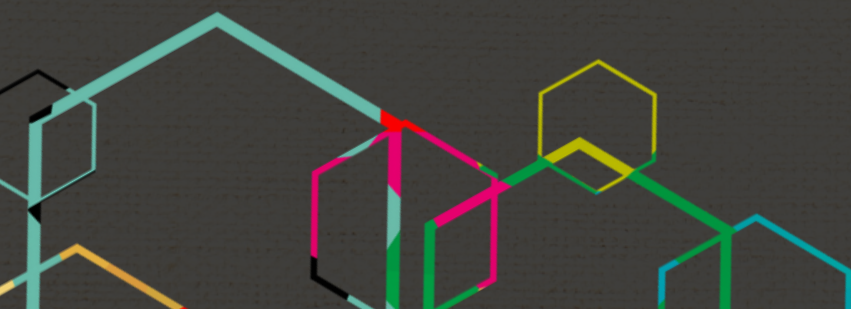
